We are hearing from some community partners about negative comments they are receiving following recent social media posts.

On Friday February 18th, during the demonstrations in Ottawa, there was an interaction between a Toronto Police Officer on a horse and a woman.

In an unrelated incident, screen shots containing images, text and participant details of an online chat forum used by some RCMP Musical Ride members emerged on social media.

Negative comments are being posted on social media linking the two events.

With respect to the incident involving a Toronto Police Officer on a horse, the Ontario Special Investigations Unit in investigating and we will await their findings.

We are aware of the material circulating on social media pertaining to a some of our members, and we can confirm that we are looking into the matter. This material is not representative of the vast majority who have committed themselves to serving Canadians with integrity and professionalism. Public trust is essential for the RCMP to effectively fulfill its mandate. RCMP employees are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that meets the rightfully high expectations of Canadians. Both on and off-duty, members are required to behave in accordance with the Code of Conduct of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.

Here are the Communications and media highlights as of 8 a.m.

- The Prime Minister will deliver remarks and hold a media availability at 11:00am. The event will also be
 attended by: Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance Chrystia Freeland, Minister of Justice and Attorney
 General of Canada David Lametti, Minister of Public Safety Marco Mendicino and Minister of Emergency
 Preparedness Bill Blair.
- The House of Commons will vote on the Emergency Act at 8:00pm tonight. It's being reported that it will likely
 pass with the joint support of the Liberals and NDP, while the Bloc Quebecois and the Conservative parties are
 against it.
- The Coventry Road location previously occupied by an unlawful assembly is now clear. 20 vehicles were towed
 and a police presence will remain in place to prevent anyone from returning. (OPS Tweet)
- Leaked Musical Ride screenshots continue to be shared and retweeted on social media. (see screenshot below)
- There have been no media requests so far today.

MPs to vote tonight on decision to invoke Emergencies Act

MPs will vote on the motion Monday at 8 p.m. ET, and it is expected to pass with the joint support of the Liberals and NDP. The Bloc Quebecois and the Conservatives are against it. If the motion fails, the act and all the extraordinary powers stemming from it will be torn up. If it passes they will remain in place until mid-March at the latest.






