This is further to your *Access to Information Act* (ATIA) request for:

Records relevant to your request have been identified; however, consultation with another government agency is required. Therefore, pursuant to paragraph 9 (1)(b) of the ATIA, an extension of **160 days** beyond the statutory time limit is needed.
