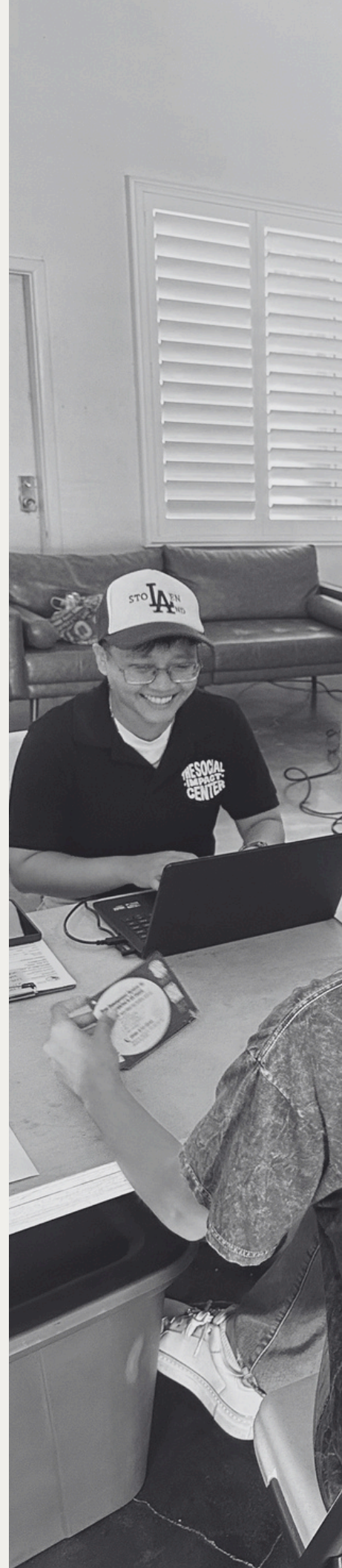

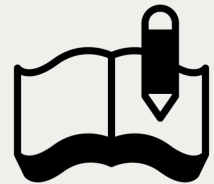

At the start of 2025, we adapted our programs in response to the wildfires across California. Despite these challenges, our commitment to serving system-impacted individuals remained at the heart of our work—driving meaningful programming, expanding our reach, and strengthening partnerships with community organizations.

Hollywood Expungement Event

In collaboration with ManifestWorks, we kicked off the year in Hollywood at Smuggler Studios with a powerful Expungement Service Event.

ManifestWorks bridged the gap for individuals impacted by foster care, homelessness, and incarceration by connecting them to job opportunities through immersive learning and real-world work experience.

Our expert team was on-site to guide participants through the expungement process, helping them take meaningful steps toward a brighter future.



4th Justice and Wellness Fair

We invited passionate providers focused on justice, equity, and wellness to join our planning committee for the 4th Annual San Fernando Valley Justice & Wellness Resource Fair. Hosted by the CAP Alliance, CSUN's Project Rebound, and The Social Impact Center, the fair was dedicated to supporting system-impacted students, formerly incarcerated individuals, and their families. Together, we created a powerful space for resource sharing and community connection.

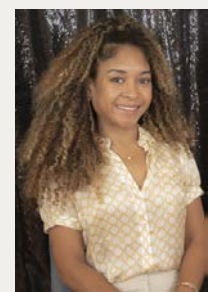
LEEF Fellow Culmination

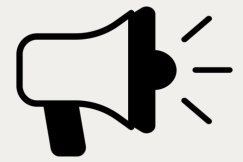

Hybrid Expungement Model

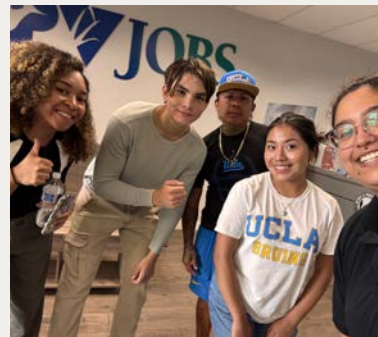

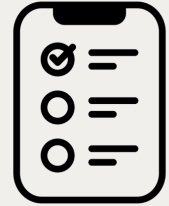
Collaborating with ARC

Helping the most marginalized



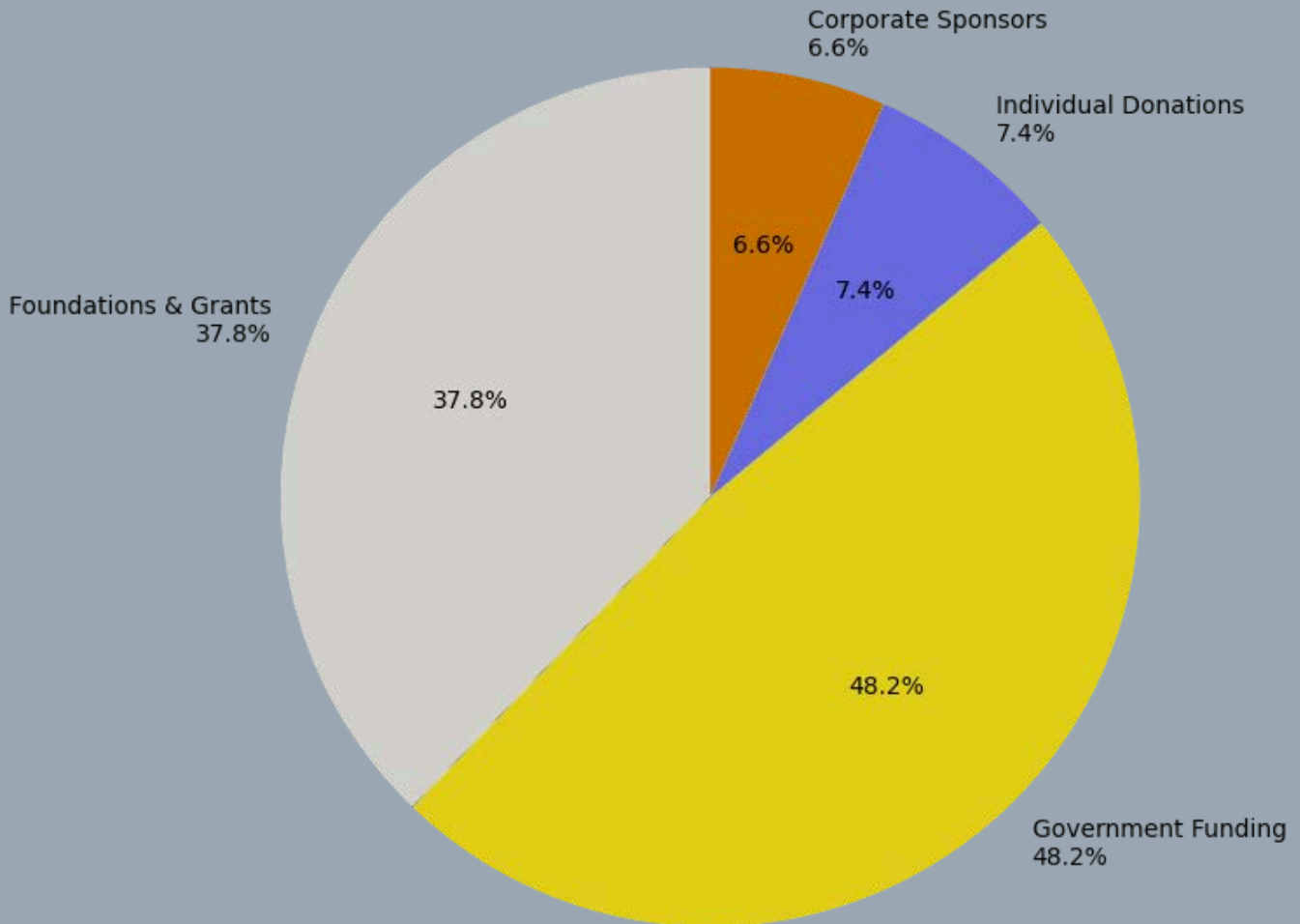
We partnered with Humanity Heroes to help stuff 3,000 Backpacks for homeless people in LA county and nationwide.

Total Raised Breakdown

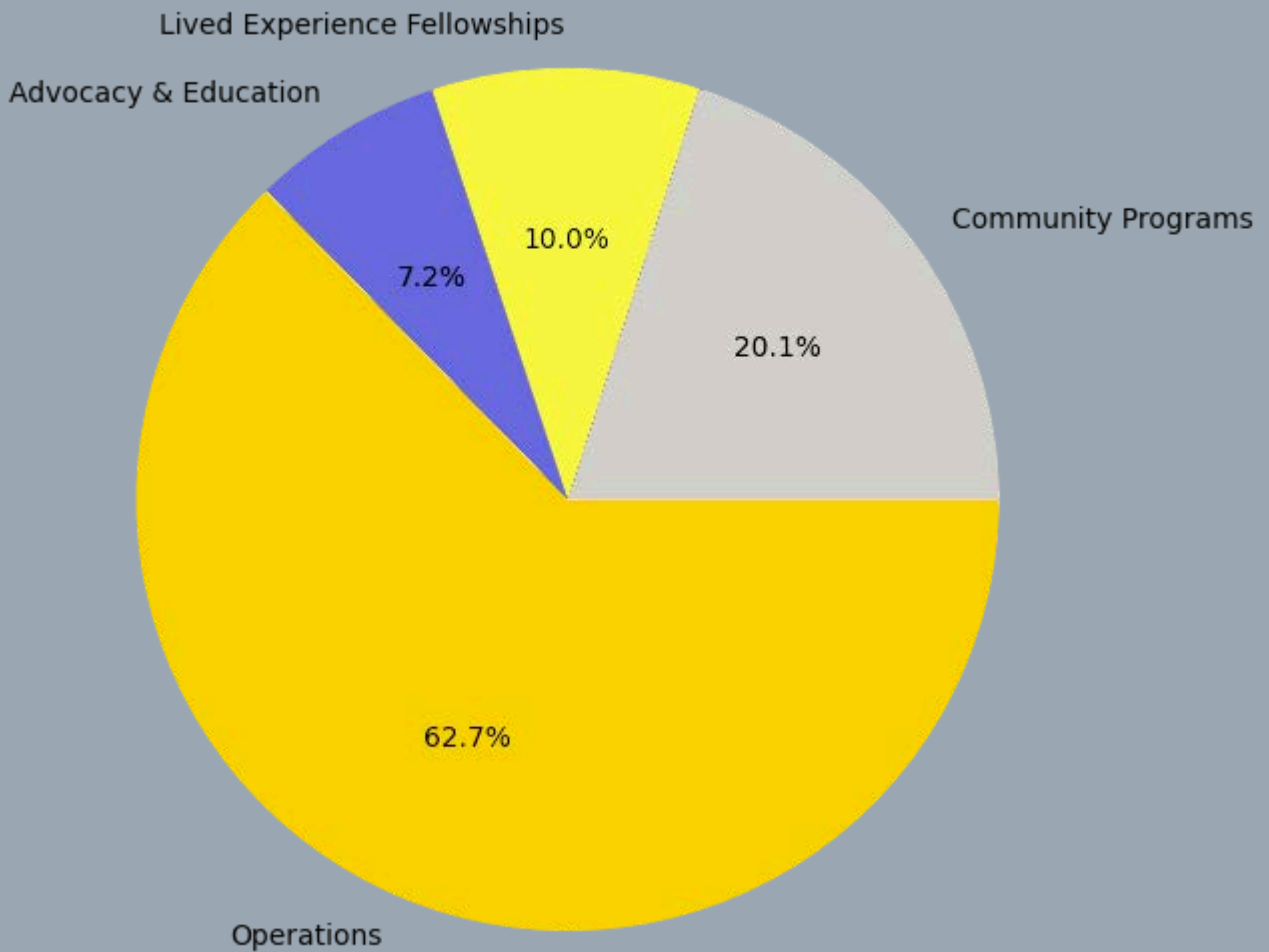
