# Our purpose

TPT's purpose is to conserve, learn and share knowledge about Tasmanian threatened plants by:

- (a) Undertaking on ground recovery actions for priority species;
- (b) Conducting surveys and monitoring to improve our knowledge;
- (c) Sharing our love and passion of plants;
- (d) Collaborating with others to achieve our conservation objectives; and
- (e) Learning through sharing our collective knowledge.

## Significant Changes

No significant change in the nature of TPT's purpose occurred during the year.

#### Membership

As at 30 June 2025 TPT has 172 paid up members, a net increase of 52 from 2023-24 financial year.

#### Principal activities for 2024-25 financial year

This financial year, in support of our purpose, TPT members provided approximately 980 volunteer hours in the field over 25 days to assist our partner organisations with field surveys. Partner organisations this year included:

#### Note 1: Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

This financial report is a special purpose report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations *Incorporation Act Tasmania*. The Committee has determined that the Association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report is prepared on a cash basis, whereby items are recognised when money is paid or received as recorded in the records of TPT in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act Tasmania.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

#### a. Income Tax
