

Volunteer Opportunity

Community Ambassador

As a Community Ambassador, your role is to interact and engage the public at various events to promote Thames Talbot Land Trust (TTLT) and inspire people to seek further engagement with TTLT. In this role, you will have the chance to chat one-on-one with individuals and groups about nature protection and how they can get involved in conserving natural spaces in their local communities.

Responsibilities

As a Community Ambassador you will be responsible for:

- Interacting with individuals at booth events to promote TTLT and the work we do
- Setting up and taking down booth displays
- Presenting for groups/clubs at private events about TTLT and the work we do
- Mentoring new Community Ambassadors when a certain level of comfortability and experience have been met (to be decided on a case-by-case basis)
- Reporting to the Community Liaison Coordinator

Time Commitment

This role is very flexible depending on your availability. We ask volunteers to commit to attending at least 4 community events or speaking opportunities per year.

Training

Training and resources will be provided to prepare you for the varied tasks and conversation topics. We encourage you to attend a volunteer orientation event (posted at www.thamestalbotlandtrust.ca/events calendar).

Skills and Experience

No prior experience is needed, but the following will be helpful:

- Knowledge about Thames Talbot Land Trust
- Excellent communication and public speaking skills
- Enthusiasm for connecting with individuals and groups in the community
- Knowledge of, or interest in, southwestern Ontario's ecology

Other Requirements

Depending on the location of events, access to your own transportation would be an asset. If you do not have access to transportation, please still get in touch. We may be able to facilitate carpooling or other transportation options.
