Environmental Education Coordinator

As an Environmental Education Coordinator, your role is to get youth involved in TTLT's environmental education programming. Our environmental education includes classroom modules and sessions and/or field trips where youth can learn about nature and develop hands-on conservation skills. You will be involved in communicating and coordinating with educators and youth group leaders to talk about TTLT environmental education programming and schedule classroom visits and field trips. In this role, you will have the chance to connect younger generations to nature and the possibilities that it holds for their futures.

Responsibilities

As an Environmental Education Coordinator, you will have the opportunity to participate in a range of tasks, including:

- Communicating with educators and youth groups leaders
- Coordinating classroom visits and field trips
- Coordinating Environmental Educator volunteers
- Tracking expenses incurred

Time Commitment

The time commitment for this role will vary based on the school year calendar. The busiest months are typically September to November and March to May. During these times, the time commitment for this role is approximately 10-15 hours per month. We ask volunteers to commit to a full school year (e.g. September to June).

Training

You will be provided with training and resources. We encourage you to attend a volunteer orientation event (posted at www.thamestalbotlandtrust.ca/events_calendar).

Skills and Experience

No prior experience is needed, but the following may be helpful, depending on the specific roles and modules you sign up for:

- Strong communication skills
- Experience in event and volunteer coordination
- Knowledge of, or interest in, SW Ontario's ecology
