Video Content Creator & Editor

As a Video Content Creator & Editor, your role is to assist with creating and editing video communications material. This may include preparing nature videos, how-to or instructional videos, promotional/fundraising videos and other content for social media posts, campaigns, and general information sharing. In this role, you will have the chance to use your creativity to inspire a passion for nature protection in your local communities.

Responsibilities

As a Video Content Creator & Editor, you will be responsible for:

- Developing video content for social media, YouTube, the TTLT website, etc.
- Assisting in the creation, filming, and editing of video content for social media, campaigns, etc.
- Reporting to the Communications Coordinator

Time Commitment

This is a casual position. You can choose how many videos you want to assist with and how frequently.

Training

We will assist you in using free video editing software, if necessary, and will provide guidance on the best practices that align with TTLT's values. We encourage you to attend a TTLT Volunteer Orientation event (posted at <u>www.thamestalbotlandtrust.ca/events_calendar</u>).

Skills and Experience

Experience in video creating and editing is required. The following will also be helpful:

- Strong written and communication skills
- Experience with creating or editing communication work designed to be shared with the public
- Knowledge of, or interest in, southwestern Ontario's ecology

Other requirements

Access to your own camera would be an asset (it doesn't have to be anything fancy, your cell phone camera would be fine!). TTLT can lend out a tablet if you don't have your own camera.
