

Volunteer Opportunity

Community Liaison Coordinator

As a Community Liaison Coordinator, your role is to organize community engagement opportunities to promote Thames Talbot Land Trust (TTLT). Engagement opportunities could include community fairs and events that TTLT can have a booth at, speaking engagements with other clubs and groups, and other opportunities that may arise. In this role, you will have the chance to coordinating with community partners and inspire a passion for nature protection.

Responsibilities

As a Community Liaison Coordinator you will be responsible for:

- Finding community engagement opportunities for TTLT to participate in
- Coordinating booth leads, booth shepherds, photographers, and Student Ambassadors for outreach events and activities
- Reporting to the Staff Lead and/or Co-Lead

Time Commitment

We ask volunteers to commit to at least a year in this role. Hours may vary seasonally but on average we expect a time commitment of approximately 4-10 hours per month.

Training

No training is required, but we encourage you to attend a volunteer orientation event (posted at www.thamestalbotlandtrust.ca/events calendar).

Skills and Experience

No prior experience is needed, but the following will be helpful:

- Experience with event planning would be an asset
- Experience coordinating volunteers would be an asset
- Excellent people skills, including communication and leadership skills
- Excellent organization and attention to detail
- Strong written and communication skills
- Knowledge of, or interest in, southwestern Ontario's ecology
