

TTLT Booth Setup

Outreach Display

There are two types of table setup depending on whether or not we are selling merchandise.

Booth without merchandise

Display items include: black tablecloth, white logoed tablecloth runner, TaTTler newsletters (the two most recent versions), Passport to Nature booklets, TTLT bookmarks, a clipboard with an email signup sheet, a map with TTLT nature reserves, ways to follow us online, and materials stands.



Depending on the event, booths may include other items such as Job Opportunity info sheets, photo op handhelds, native seed packets, etc.

Booth with merchandise

Display items include all of those from above as well as items to be sold such as: t-shirts, hats, cards, notepaper, and Audobon birds.



Outdoor Displays

Some community outreach opportunities will be outdoors. If this is the case, you will need to use the TTLT tent – it takes at least 2 people to put up, so the more the merrier. Don't be afraid to ask neighbouring booths for help if you ever need it.

For grassy areas, there are tent pegs to help hold the tent down. If the tent is on pavement, it will need to be weighted down. We currently borrow tent weights, but are in the process of owning our own. Just do the best you can.

Some items, such as t-shirts, can hang from the tent on clothes hangers. As long as it looks nice and isn't obscuring peoples' view or access to the table.
