Jewish Blind & Disabled (JBD) is the only Jewish charity providing housing and support for people, aged 18 upwards, with physical disabilities or vision impairment.

We provide developments of mobility apartments for people to live independently and in safety behind their own front door. Our Occupational Therapy Service offers help and support for people living in their own home in the community. We also run support groups for people with sight loss and Multiple Sclerosis.

The majority of the people we support are not born with a disability, instead, at some point in their lives they face a diagnosis that will have a significant impact on their life from that time forward.
