**Candidate Disclosure: Freedom of Religion and Family Values**

I believe in freedom of religion for every Utahn and expect government to protect this unalienable right, including the free expression of faith in both public and private life. My personal belief, grounded in my Christian faith, is that marriage is a biblical covenant between one man and one woman, and that belief guides my own life and faith community. At the same time, I believe government should not use one religious belief to deny civil marriage rights to others. Protecting religious freedom means keeping government limited, neutral, and respectful—while treating every citizen fairly under the law.

**Candidate Disclosure: The Caucus and Convention System**

I respect the Utah Republican Party platform and the historic role of the caucus and convention system in building grassroots leadership. My intent is not to undermine that system or the authority of delegates, but to operate fully within Utah law while expanding voter engagement in a large, rural district like House District 67.

As a first-time candidate, I also recognize that many delegates do not yet know me personally. In a district that spans multiple counties with long travel distances, shift-work employment, and family responsibilities, caucus participation can be difficult for many otherwise active Republicans. Exploring the signature-gathering option allows me to meet voters where they are, introduce myself directly, and build broader familiarity—while still participating in caucus events, meeting with delegates, and respecting the convention process. My goal is transparency, accountability, and party unity, so Republican voters, delegates, and party leadership can all have confidence in the process and the nominee.
