We're taking literacy to new heights with Over the Edge!

Over the Edge is an adrenaline-fueled, unique fundraising event that provides participants the thrilling, once in a lifetime chance of rappelling down a building in an exciting and completely safe environment. On August 8, 2026, participants who raise \$1,000 or more for Imagination Library of Washington will step to the edge, take a breath, and rappel 86 feet down the Hilton Vancouver Washington!

Who Can Volunteer?

ANYONE!

There are several opportunities to lend a hand for Over the Edge. From registration, to staging, to landing zone and ropes volunteers, there is something for everyone. For our ropes volunteers, previous experience with rope safety systems (climbers, cavers, firefighters and SWAT, etc.) is preferred but NOT required. For people 18 and under, parent permission is required.

GENERAL EVENT VOLUNTEER

- Registration (participant check-in)
- Participant Guide (leading groups to staging, training area)
- Staging Area
- Landing Zone/Ground Party
- Rooftop Security/Rooftop Radio Lead
- Floater (assist other staff)

ROPES VOLUNTEER

- Full-day commitment on event day, along with mandatory training the day prior.
- Works closely with the Over the Edge technical team
- Can rappel for FREE as a thank you!
- Time requirements:
 - 1-hour online safety video before event
 - Attend a 3-hour training session on August 7 (VIP/Media Day)
 - 8am-5pm commitment on rappel day
