


Vermont Farmers Food Center Campus Renovation Project Community Update #1

Farmers Hall Gets Heated Floors!

Last year, we installed radiant heat tubing throughout Farmers Hall. This summer, we took the next step and installed a Maine Heating Systems pellet boiler that's now up and running! This new system is part of our larger energy efficiency upgrades.

Fun fact: The pellets filling our new silo are made just down the road in Clarendon, VT!

The new heating system will make everyone's Winter Farmers Market experience warmer and more comfortable, while also reducing heating costs through the use of locally sourced alternative energy.



We also began renovations on our Commercial Kitchens

The commercial kitchens offer the opportunity for small food businesses to launch or scale their production right on campus.
