The event will be held in Grand Oaks 1. The Grand Oaks room is located on level 1 of the events centre. Enter the racecourse using the entrance off Cruse Street. From the main car park, follow the signs to Grand Oaks room. Level 1 can be accessed via stairs and a lift.

Parking is available opposite the main public gates to the racecourse. Follow on-course signage to the Oaks Function Centre.

Event Description

The main event takes place in Melbourne at the MCEC. The first half of the day (session 1a-2a) takes place in the plenary. These sessions are livestreamed to the regional locations. For the second half of the day (breakout rooms) attendees split off into groups according to their union. The breakout rooms are in-person across all locations.

Certificates will be collected at the conclusion of the event.

There will be morning tea and lunch provided to attendees on the day. Please note your dietary requirements upon registration.
