“Sense of entitlement”: Liberal signs go up without permission

Local businesswoman Marie Bird was outraged to discover Liberal Party operatives erected signs on her private property in West Warrnambool without permission.

A supporter of the Independent campaign, Ms Bird’s fence already had two signs on the fence promoting Independent candidate Alex Dyson. A Dan Tehan sign and Liberal banner appeared on Wednesday.

“I couldn’t believe it – no one should have this sense of entitlement,” said Ms Bird.

“Unfortunately this is what the Liberal Party has become here in Wannon. Instead of fixing the issues facing our community, they’re focused on dirty tactics like this.

“I’m supporting Alex Dyson because of his commitment to community and integrity. If we vote him in on Saturday, together we can finally get action on issues like better aged care – because he answers to locals, not to a political party.

“I called Dan Tehan’s office and left a message sharing my disgust that this happened.”

Ms Bird has since taken down the Liberal signs and looks forward to casting her vote for Alex Dyson.
