NEWLY ELECTED SIGNAL HILL COUNCILMEMBER ENDORSES LENA GONZALEZ FOR STATE SENATE

Gonzalez Has Most Cash-on-Hand as Campaign Enters Final Phase

LONG BEACH, CA - Continuing to dominate the field in fundraising, Long Beach City Councilwoman Lena Gonzalez announced today that she has out raised her opponents during the last campaign finance reporting period in her race to represent the 33rd State Senatorial District in the California State Senate. This is the second consecutive reporting period that Gonzalez out raises all of her opponents.

From February 10th through March 9th, Gonzalez raised \$153,815. She out raised her closest opponent by almost four times who reported raising just \$41,000 during the same reporting period. Additionally, Gonzalez has most cash-on-hand than all her fellow competitors, over \$247,000, as the campaign enters the final two weeks before the election.

Out of the eleven candidates in the race, only six filed fundraising reports. The other five most likely did not meet the threshold to file reports electronically.

A primary election will be held on Tuesday, March 26, 2019. If a run-off is needed, the run-off election will be held on Tuesday, June 4, 2019.

Councilwoman Lena Gonzalez has served on the Long Beach City Council since 2014 representing Downtown Long Beach and surrounding communities. She has served as the Vice Chair of the city's State Legislative committee for the past five years, and chairs the Harbor and Tidelands Committee.

Councilwoman Gonzalez lives in Downtown Long Beach with her husband Adam and their three sons. She graduated with a B.A. in Political Science from Cal State Long Beach and an MBA from Loyola Marymount University. She currently is employed with Microsoft, focused on issues around digital inclusion and tech equity.

The 33rd District includes the cities of Bell, Bell Gardens, Cudahy, Huntington Park, Lakewood, Long Beach, Lynwood, Maywood, Paramount, Signal Hill, South Gate, Vernon, portions of the City of Los Angeles and the unincorporated communities of Florence and Walnut Park.
