SONOMA COUNTY CANNABIS ORDINANCES



- Adopted Land Use, Health, and Tax Ords (Dec 2016)
- Measure A: Cannabis Business Tax (March 2017)
- Permit Application Acceptance (July 2017)





Personal Cultivation

- 100 sq. ft. per <u>residence</u>
- 6 plant limit on nonmedical (Prop 64)
- No outdoor in multi-family, R2, R3
- Landlord approval required
- Shall not be visible

Medical- No Plant Limit

Recreational- 6 Plant Max

CANNABIS PROGRAM: 2018

- Transition Period End: June 1, 2018
- Harmonization with State Regulations
- Inclusion/Exclusion Zones
- Recreational?



CANNABIS PERMITTING UPDATE

- 137 applications submitted as of 1/22/18
 - Most are a Combination of Cultivation
 - 10 Manufacturing
 - 5 Distributors
 - 2 Labs
 - 3 Pending Dispensaries
 - (5 Operating/Approved)
- Dry Creek Area Applications
 - Wallace Creek Rd, 1 acre cultivation
 - Mill Creek Ln, 2,400 sq ft cultivation



Cannabis Code Enforcement



- Cannabis Ordinance Enforcement Tools
 - Civil Penalties
 - Administrative Citations
 - Three Strikes Penalty
 - Liens
- Over 500 cases since Ordinance adoption
 - 60% in Rural Residential areas
 - 130 have been closed
 - 7 destroyed by fire

Violation	First Offense	Second Offense	Third Offense
Exceedance of Allowed	\$20 per sf	\$30 per sf	\$50 per sf
Non-compliance	\$1,000	\$5,000	\$10,000
Unpermitted Cannabis Use	\$10,000	\$25,000	\$50,000
