SUBJECT: Item 9: Fund Balance Report

RECOMMENDATION: That the Watershed Conservation Authority Governing Board receive and file the Fund Balance Report.

BACKGROUND: Attached as Exhibit A is the FY 22/23 Fund Balance Report with balances as of April 30, 2023.

Key changes in the Fund Balance Report are summarized below:

- 1. V15/ JPA, General Fund: Decrease in fund balance primarily due to Funding Opportunities and Claims Settlement expenditures.
- 2. V19/ River Park Operations: Decrease in fund balance due to deposits from tenants and leaseholders but the lease revenue was fully offset by a payroll transfer to cover salary, benefits, and Ranger Services expenditures.
- 3. V20/ El Encanto Operations: Decrease in fund balance due to deposits from tenants and leaseholders but the lease revenue was fully offset by a payroll transfer to cover salary, benefits, and Ranger Services expenditures.
- 4. V46/ River Park Remediation: Decrease in fund balance primarily due to construction services from Chalmers Construction and Conservation Corps of Long Beach.
- 5. V77/ LACFCD Overlook: Decrease in fund balance primarily due to construction services from Chalmers Construction.
- 6. V78/ River Wilderness Park Entry: Decrease in fund balance due to reversal of project management related expenditures and replenished the transferred funds to the RMC Subvention.
- 7. V2A/ SG Foothills & Mountains Acquisition: Decrease in fund balance due to reversal of project management related expenditures and replenished the transferred funds to the RMC Subvention.
- 8. V2D/ RMC Subvention: Increase in fund balance primarily due to the replenishment of temporarily transferred funds for project management related expenditures from the River Park Supplemental Environmental, River Wilderness Park Entry and San Gabriel Foothills & Mountains Acquisition Projects but partially offset by the project management related expenditures from Parque Dos Rios Improvements and River Park Projects.

9. V2E/ River Park Supplemental Environmental Project: Decrease in fund balance due to reversal of temporarily transferred funds for the project Management labor and other project expenditures.
