## RECOMMENDATION

That the Watershed Conservation Authority Governing Board receive and file the Fund Balance Report.

## **BACKGROUND**

Attached as Exhibit A is the FY 24/25 Fund Balance Report with balances as of May 31, 2025.

Key changes in the Fund Balance Report are summarized below:

- 1. Accounts with a fund balance change greater than \$1,000 include: V15, V19, V20, V52, V2B, and V2D.
- 2. V15/JPA General Fund: The decrease in the fund balance is primarily due to administrative and operational expenditures.
- 3. V19/River Park Operations: The increase in the fund balance is primarily attributed to deposits received from leaseholders. However, this was partially offset by operational expenses.
- 4. V20/El Encanto Operations: The increase in the fund balance is primarily due to deposits received from tenants and leaseholders; however, this was partially offset by operational expenses.
- 5. V52/Various Projects: The fund balance increased due to reimbursement requests received from various projects, including the Mount Baldy Wilderness Preserve Fuel Modification Project and the Lower Los Angeles River Ranger Pilot Program Implementation. However, this increase was partially offset by payroll and administrative expenses.
- 6. V2B/ San Gabriel Valley Greenway Network Strategic Implementation Plan: The increase in the fund balance is primarily attributed to interest earned during May 2025.
- 7. V2D/ RMC Subvention: The decrease in the fund balance is due to project management-related expenditures from various projects, including the Community Connection to Wildlands, the San Gabriel River Center Development Project, and the Azusa River Wilderness Project. However, this decrease was partially offset by the replenishment of temporarily transferred funds from the Walnut Creek Project Management.
