SUBJECT: Item 11: Fund Balance Report

RECOMMENDATION: That the Watershed Conservation Authority Governing Board receive and file the Fund Balance Report.

BACKGROUND: Attached as Exhibit A is the FY 18/19 Fund Balance Report with balances as of January 31, 2019.

Key changes in the Fund Balance Report are summarized below:

- 1. V52/V15 Personnel: Increase in fund balance primarily due to reimbursement of project management labor activities from the South Gate/Parque Dos Rios and Tree Planting Enhancement projects, subsequently replenishing to operational funds.
- 2. V31/South Gate Operational: Decrease in fund balance primarily due to the temporarily utilization of operational reserves to fund labor and other expenditures to various units while the Authority awaits reimbursements from existing grants and contacts.
- 3. V48/ South Gate Riparian Implementation: Decrease in fund balance primarily due to project management labor and associated expenditures.
- 4. V52/River Wilderness Park Entry: Decrease in fund balance due to reverse temporary transferred funds to operational for project management labor and associated expenditures.
- 5. V52/LCWA Support: Decrease in fund balance due to reverse temporary transferred funds to operational for professional services.
- 6. V52/ Crystal Lake: Decrease in fund balance due to reverse temporary transferred funds to operational for project management labor and associated expenditures.
- 7. V76/ Duck Farm Tree Grant: Decrease in fund balance due to project management labor activities.
- 8. V85/Gateway Cities & River Urban Greening: Decrease in fund balance due to project management labor activities and associated payments.
