Did you know that San Jose is evaluating the requirement to mandate the electrification of existing residential structures?

Pg 13: "In order to reach our ambitious Climate Smart goals [achieve carbon naturality on a 2030 timeline], we will need to eliminate the use of fossil fuels in buildings, primarily natural gas, and replace them with clean and efficient electric technologies--a process called building electrification."

Pg 47: "Because voluntary action by property owners will not be sufficient to fully electrify San José's buildings by the City's 2030 carbon neutrality goal date, new laws that require electrification for every building sector will be necessary."
