Stay up to Date on Issues affecting Willow Glen!

WGNA continues to follow government proposals and new laws which affect Willow Glen residents.

The City of San Jose continues to discuss whether or not to require existing homeowners to replace certain gas appliances for electric appliances. Nothing final however, something definitive expected by mid November.

The house at 1231 Minnesota Ave is being offered at a discount to non profits for a potential residential development site.

New state law AB2011 and SB6 circumvents local control and allows for the conversion of commercial land (such as Lincoln Ave and Meridian Ave) to high density housing.

AB2147 was signed by the governor to allow jaywalking so please be careful for pedestrians when driving.

WGNA is dedicated to the beautification, as well as community building in our magnificent Willow Glen. Throughout the year we sponsor beautification projects such as <u>Art Boxes</u>, <u>Neighborhood Cleanup / Dumpster Days</u>, <u>National Night Out</u>, and the installation of an <u>Illuminated Clock in Downtown Willow Glen</u>.
