

Neighborhood Planning Updates:

The former gas station at the corner of Lincoln and Curtner has been vacant for approximately twenty years.

It has had several owners over the years who either did not move forward with reopening or went forward with construction without a permit. A new entity purchased the property and submitted plans to the City in 2020.

The City of San Jose Planning Commission approved the applicant's plans in 2021 along with the updated federal and state regulations. The new owner is in the gas station business and obtained the financing in 2022 to start construction this month which includes all of the necessary underground work.

Opening will be approximately Q4.

Willow Glen Cares & Shares

Cassoulet of Baked Cheeses with Fennel-Leek Confit is a Kenter-DeTomasi family favorite. Created by board member and long time Willow Glen resident, Mary Kenter Fox's uncle Silvio DeTomasi. It is a rich, creamy, flavorful appetizer which will serve 4-6 people.

Cassoulet of Baked Cheeses with Fennel-Leek Confit

4 ounces Brie

3 ounces Camembert

1 ounce fontina

4 ounces goat cheese

1/2 ounce fresh chives

1/3 cup cold pressed olive oil

6 ounces fennel

6 ounces leeks

Salt, fresh ground pepper

4 ounces butter

Olive oil to garnish (I like a sprig of rosemary or basil 🐇 too)

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Combine all the cheeses and chives, then place into a baking dish. Lightly butter sides of baking dish if needed.
- 2. In sauce pot on low heat, sauté leeks and fennel in the olive oil. Season with fresh ground pepper and salt. Add the butter, cook low heat until vegetables are soft.
- 3. Pour mixture over cheese and bake until cheese is bubbling, about 20 minutes.
- 4. Garnish cheese with drizzle of cold-pressed olive oil and a touch of black pepper. Serve with lightly brushed olive oil, oven toasted, sourdough crostini.
