Re: Procedural Fairness Concerns – T-705-13 (MediaTube v. Bell Canada)

Dear Minister Fraser and Ms. Perrier,

Please find enclosed a copy of my urgent letter of today's date addressed to Associate Judge Crinson in Federal Court file T-705-13.

This letter sets out my concerns that:

- Evidence I filed on June 11, 2025, showing that court exhibits had been altered, was marked "received" by the Court but never posted;
- My June 23, 2025 motion was filed and served in compliance with the Court's direction but has not been posted or ruled on;
- Bell Canada was ordered on June 16, 2025 to file its responding defence by July 4, 2025, and has failed to do so;
- Despite Bell Canada's default, its contempt motion filed June 13, 2025 was immediately posted and processed, while my filings have been suppressed;
- Repeated requests for direction in July, August, and September 2025 have gone unanswered.

These issues raise serious concerns under **Rule 3 of the Federal Courts Rules**, which requires that all proceedings be determined justly, expeditiously, and on their merits. Continued suppression of my evidence and inaction on my motion undermines this standard and places me, as a self-represented litigant, at a severe disadvantage.

I am bringing this matter to your attention because it implicates not only my case, but also the integrity of the Federal Court's administration of justice.
