PETITION TO SAVE THE GREATER BLUE MOUNTAINS WORLD HERITAGE AREA AND ITS WILD RIVERS FROM THE RAISING OF WARRAGAMBA DAM WALL

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled.

The petition of Blue Mountains residents and other concerned citizens of NSW brings to the attention of the House NSW Government plans to inundate 65 kilometres of pristine wild rivers and 4,700 hectares of National Parks, including 1,000 hectares of the Greater Blue Mountains World Heritage Area, by the raising of Warragamba Dam wall.
