Resolution asking City Council to reconsider PAVE Grant

WHEREAS the Corpus Christi City Council passed an Ordinance authorizing acceptance of a Partnering for Vaccine Equity (PAVE) Grant for \$75,000.00, from the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO).

WHEREAS the Corpus Christi City Council designated this \$75,000.00 Grant Fund to provide Communications Campaign to Strengthen COVID-19 and Influenza vaccination uptake

Whereas The goal of this grant is to provide education and vaccine delivery to the community at the local level.

WHEREAS this grant comes with unacceptable strings attached to:

- 1) push the COVID vaccine in minority communities,
- 2) report to the federal government the name of the people who refuse to accept the vaccine.

WHEREAS, according to a weekly analysis of CDC's own Vaccine Adverse Effects Reporting System (VAERS), for the United States only there is an alarming 227% increase in reported deaths caused by COVID-19 injections since December 2020 compared with reported deaths from all other vaccines combined since 1990, with over 1 million reported adverse reactions[i]; and

WHEREAS, multiple medical and scientific organizations provide conflict-of-interest-free research and analysis and peer-reviewed case studies on the safety and efficacy of vitamins, supplements, drugs, and injections used in COVID-19 treatment and prevention, which have documented harm to individuals who have received mRNA gene-therapy injections and CDC-defined adverse events of special interest (AESI): death, myocarditis/pericarditis, acute respiratory distress syndrome, stroke, multisystem ages inflammatory syndrome, COVID-19 disease (VAX failure), acute myocardial infarction, menstrual/female reproductive disorders, and appendicitis[ii]; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Committee of Nueces County Republican Party supports the effort by our conservative council members, to place the PAVE grant back on the agenda to revisit the prior vote taken by the Corpus Christi City Council. And,

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Committee of the Nueces County Republican Party UNCONDITIONALLY supports full public disclosure of the mortality and adverse effects caused by mRNA gene-therapy COVID injections, and that any Nueces County and City of Corpus Christi initiatives and/or ordinances require all county and city government entities and/or entities utilizing public funding to provide written consent from individuals before administering any mRNA gene-therapy injections. Written consent must include at a minimum the listing of the following adverse effects: death, myocarditis/pericarditis, acute respiratory distress syndrome, stroke, multisystem organ inflammatory syndrome, COVID-19 disease (VAX failure), acute myocardial infarction, menstrual/female reproductive disorders, and appendicitis. As elected officials, the Nueces County Commissioners Court and City of Corpus Christi City Council have authority over the Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District, and as such are ultimately responsible for the safety and welfare of all citizens and residents.
