LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

Winchester City Museum, The Square – 10am-5pm – FREE entry all day on Saturday 19 February for children and their families! This museum is in the heart of the city and tells the story of England's ancient capital, the seat of Alfred the Great. The model of 1870 Winchester is a hit with children and adults alike.

Westgate Museum, Upper High Street – **10am-4pm** – **FREE** entry all day on Saturday 19 February for children and their families!

Winchester City Mill, Bridge Street – 11am-4pm – FREE entry – plus milling demonstrations, interactive activity stations and '50 things to do before you're 11¾' activities designed for ages 5-12.

The Royal Green Jackets (Rifles) Museum, Peninsula Barracks – 10am-4pm – FREE entry for children under 16 – PLUS half-price entry for all adults in the family. This has been described as an "under-appreciated gem", with its diorama of the Battle of Waterloo a particular highlight.

The Rifles Museum, Peninsula Barracks – **10am-4pm** – **FREE** entry for children and the rest of the family. This museum focuses on the largest regiment in the Army and offers dressing up and other activities for youngsters.
