

Vimy Victory Garden Application 2023

Thanks for your interest in the Vimy Victory gardens! We're excited about the 2023 growing season and look forward to meeting you. Please review the responsibilities of the Community Garden Committee and the Community Gardener, and fill out the application. If you know someone interested in gardening, please encourage them to apply.

Garden Applications are due by February 28th, 2023. The allotment lottery will be held in early March and successful applicants will be notified no later than March 17th, 2023.

Priority will be given to:

1. Community residents that don't have access to yard space.
2. People living within the boundaries of Wolseley neighbourhood (Between Portage Ave. and the Assiniboine River N/S and Sherbrook and Omand's Creek E/W). Note: do not hesitate to apply if you live outside of these boundaries.

The Wolseley Residents' Association Community Garden Committee (WRA CGC) agrees to:

- Improve, protect, and maintain the community gardens;
- Host workshops to provide education and training for all community gardeners;
- Communicate regularly with gardeners to identify assets and needs (Whats App and/or email);
- Promote community events held in the gardens in our newsletter and on social media;
- Inform community members of City requirements for use of the land.
- **Note:** The WRA CGC is not responsible for any theft or vandalism that may occur in allotment plots.

I, the Community Gardener agree to:

- Contribute 1-2 hours of my time per month to maintain the compost bins, community garden beds and orchard;
- Plant my 4X8' allotment plot by June 15th, 2023;
- Clean up my plot by the second week in October and make it tidy for winter;
- Pick up garbage and litter in the community garden area;
- Refrain from using chemicals (pesticides/herbicides) in the allotment and community gardens;
- Weed my plot and keep paths clear;
- Be respectful to other gardeners and their families;
- Help to maintain the overall appearance of the garden;
- Encourage and welcome new folks to become involved and refer them to the WRA CGC to register;
- Report any incidents of theft or vandalism it to the committee.
