Title of motion you wish to amend: Accelerating Climate Justice

Motion text you wish to amend:

Lines 13 and 15.

- 1. Immediately establishes a national scheme to fully fund the insulation of all social housing and all new build properties in Britain by 2025.
- 2. Within 6 months produce and implement a legally binding national plan to fully fund full low energy and low-carbon whole-house retrofit, and reinstate grants for installation of renewable energy, for all homes in Britain by 2030.

Wording of amendment:

- 1 The following to be added to line 13 'for the relevant developers to fully fund insulation costs of':
- Immediately establishes a national scheme to fully fund the insulation of all social housing and for the relevant developers to fully fund insulation costs of all new build properties in Britain by 2025.
- 5 The following to be added to line 15 ', which should be means tested,'
- Within 6 months produce and implement a legally binding national plan to fully fund full low energy and low-carbon whole-house retrofit, and reinstate grants, which should be means tested, for installation of renewable energy, for all homes in Britain by 2030.

Amendment rationale

- 9 We support this motion but would want developers of new-build properties to be responsible for
- 10 funding the insulation of the properties they build and to follow government regulations. We also
- believe that funding for the retrofitting of houses should have an income threshold, applied through
- means testing, so wealthy people should be required to fund their own retrofits.
