line 16: 'Reviewing past, current and future Policies, Manifestos and Public Statements by way of the IA,'

Wording of amendment:

- 1 Noting and endorsing the motion to adopt a WEP LGBTQI+ inclusion policy, WE's Steering
- 2 Committee commends the following revisions to Conference:
- 3 in line 15 delete 'should' and replace it with 'may' as follows: 'the policy should may include but is
- 4 not restricted to', to read, 'the policy may include but is not restricted to', and
- in line 16: delete 'past,' as follows: 'Reviewing past, current and future Policies,' to read, 'Reviewing
- 6 current and future Policies,'

Amendment rationale

- 7 WE's Steering Committee:
- is eager to facilitate an LGBTQI+ inclusion policy in collaboration with the LGBTQI+ Caucus
- and will support this motion;
- believes these amendments will give the SC's and LGBTQI+ Caucus's collaboration
 additional leeway and freedom to develop a policy that delivers what this motion has set out
 to achieve, without pre-empting the outcome of that development work, which will ultimately
 create a better policy; and
- believes this will allow the SC to make best use of its limited time and resources; and so
- asks Conference to vote for this amendment.
