The Land Use Action Circle is a group organized by the West Side Community Organization that meets to learn, plan, and organize around the built environment of our community.

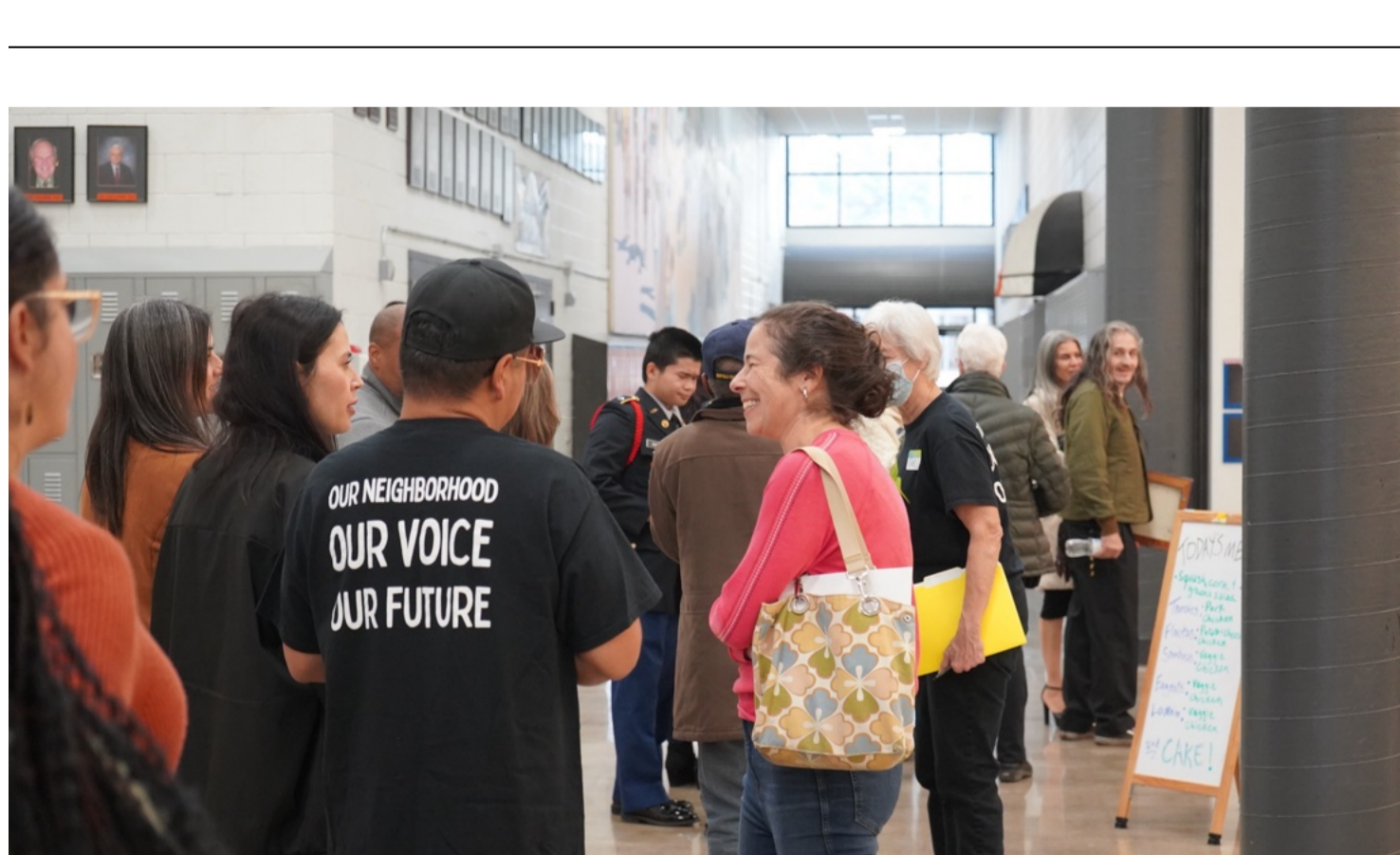

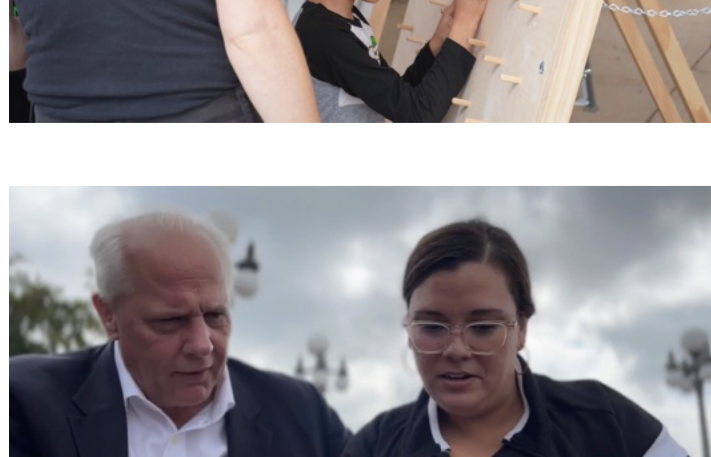
