Two critical pieces of legislation in support of the implementation of St. Paul's rent stabilization policy are being voted on at the City Council meeting on Wednesday, April 6. More than 30,000 voters said YES to rent stabilization on election day and we need to make sure OUR elected leaders pass these essential ordinances!

We know that some elected leaders say they have questions about how this policy will work. These ordinances are the essential first steps to the answers and clarity that council members — along with renters, property owners and everyone in St. Paul — are looking for.
