West Side, Best Side!

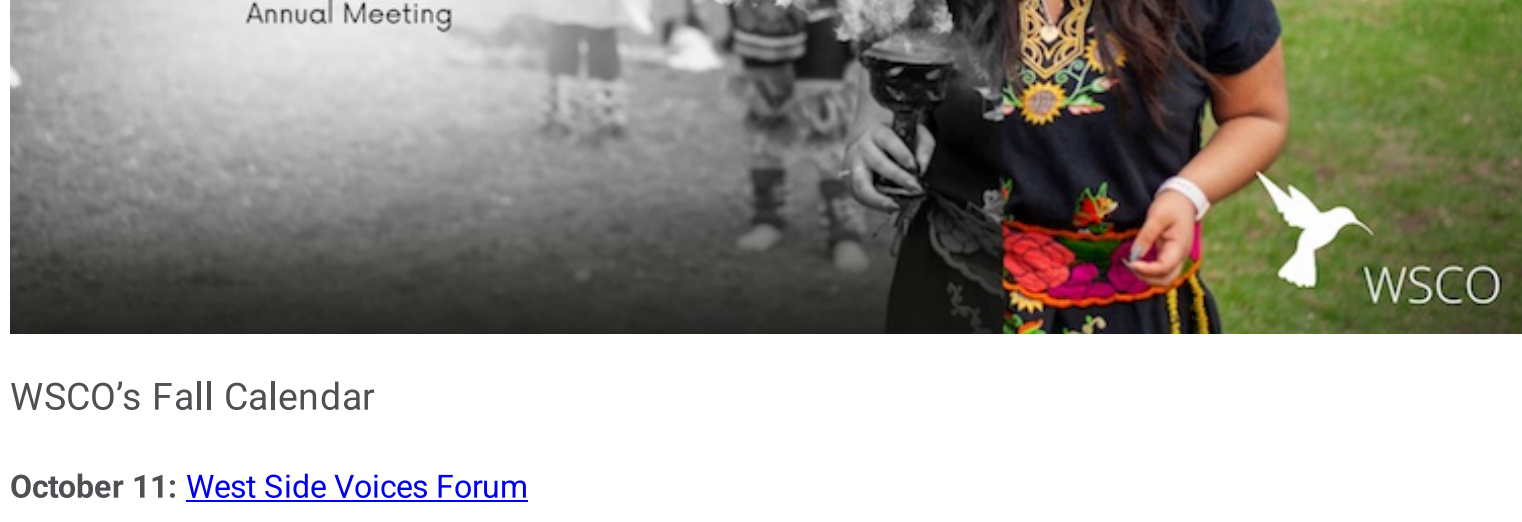

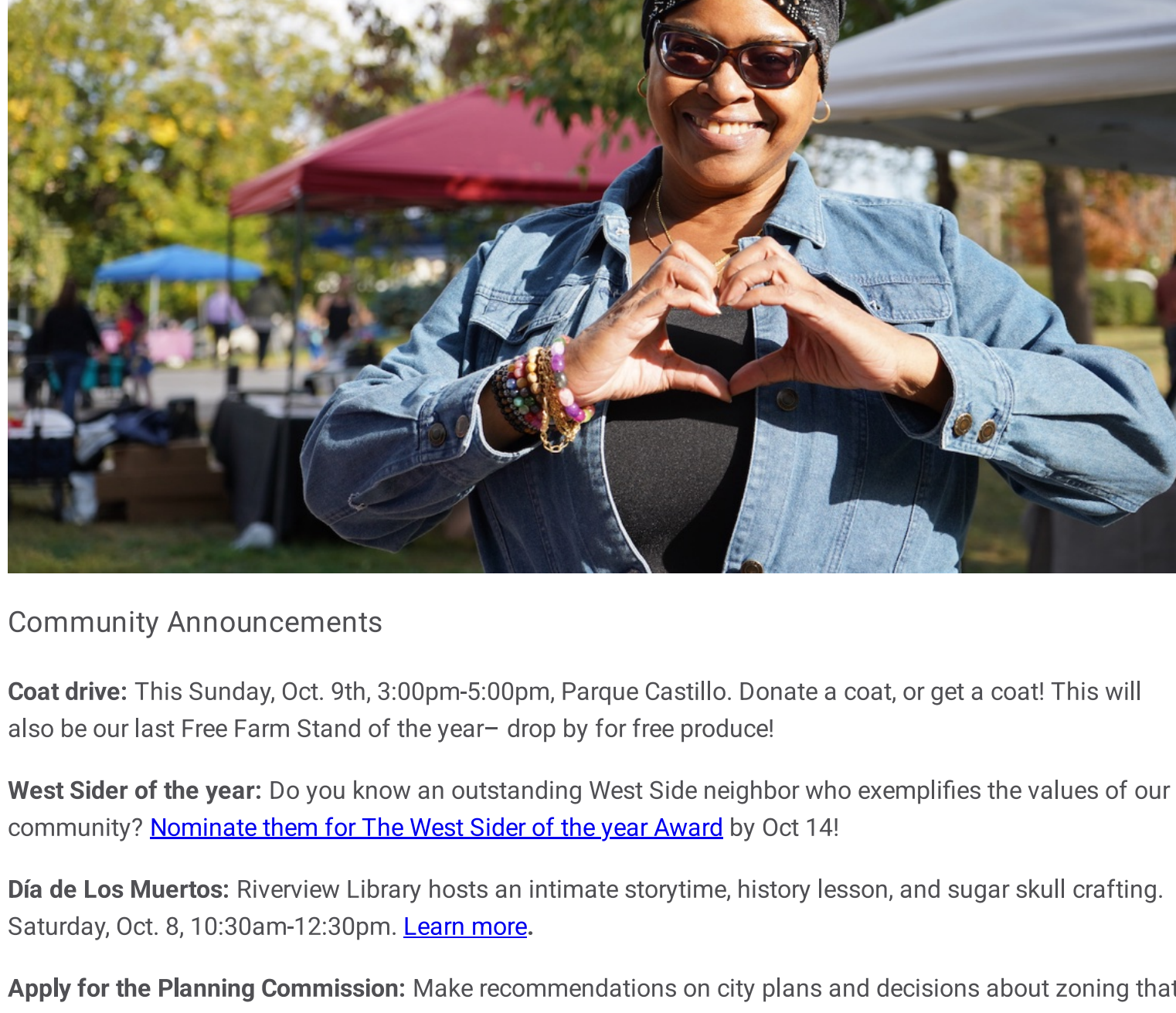
