We are requesting that all Building Representatives adhere to the timeframes set forth in our WTU Constitution and By-Laws to ensure your elections are completed. The time, date, and place of the election shall be decided by your School Chapter Advisory Committee (SCAC). Elections shall be held by secret ballot in person and there shall be no absentee balloting. All members in good standing shall have a reasonable opportunity to vote.

Please submit your results to the WTU Office no later than June 2, 2023.



- One (1) Building Representative (BR)
- Six (6) School Chapter Advisory Committee (SCAC) Members
- Four (4) Local School Advisory Team (LSAT) Members
- Four (4) Personnel Committee (PC) Members
- Delegates to Representative Assembly.

Roles and Responsibilities Of Local School Elected Positions



Building Representative - An elected representative for the Union, or a Union designee in each school, school administrative unit, or school functional unit who serves as chairperson of the School Chapter Advisory Committee (SCAC) and as the ranking delegate from each building to the Representative Assembly. The Building Representative is a member of LSAT and Personnel Committee.

School Chapter Advisory Committee (SCAC) Members - SCAC committees meet with building supervisors once a month to discuss instructional issues, school policy and questions pertaining to the implementation of the WTU-DCPS collective bargaining agreement. [SEE ARTICLE 9, WTU-DCPS CONTRACT]. SCACs consist of not more than seven (7) members of the Union (including the building rep) in each school, school administrative unit, or school functional unit. There shall be only one SchoolChapter Advisory Committee in each school, school administrative unit, or school functional unitregardless of the number of bargaining units represented by the Union, except where there is more than one supervisor.

Local School Advisory Team (LSAT) Members - An LSAT is a consensus group of administrators, parents, teachers, support staff, union representative, community representative and students who are elected and/or appointed to advise on matters of local school policy.

Personnel Committee (PC) Members - Personnel Committee Members interview and recommend all candidates for any vacant positions at the school except the position of principal. The members of the Personnel Committee will include: the administrator or his/her designee; the WTU Building Representative or his/her designee; the department head or grade level chairperson from the department or grade level affected by the vacancy (or his/her designee), or a member of the appropriate non-Teacher employee group (e.g., custodians, paraprofessionals); at least one additional Teacher, but not more than (4), elected by the WTU chapter at the school; and a parent of a current student mutually selected by both WTU Building Representative and the Supervisor.

Delegates to Representative Assembly - The general governing body of the WTU shall be the Representative Assembly. Delegates to this Assembly shall consist of members of the WTU who are elected by the members at their schools. Delegates to the Representative Assembly shall be apportioned on the basis of one for every twenty-five members or major portion thereof, with not less than one representative per building.

NOTE: All buildings must have a Personnel Committee and a Local School Advisory Team

Election Guidelines and Procedures



- 1. Only WTU members are eligible to nominate and vote in elections for the WTU Building Representative, members of the School Chapter Advisory Committee (SCAC) and delegates to the Representative Assembly.
- 2. Each school has one building representative. Only schools with 37 or fewer teachers may have an alternate building rep.
- WTU members and non-members are allowed to nominate and vote in the elections for members to serve on the Local School Advisory Team (LSAT) and the Personnel Committee (PC).
- 4. Elections shall be held by secret ballot and there shall be no absentee balloting.
- 5. The Building Representative election shall be conducted by members who are not candidates. All other elections shall be conducted by the Building Representative.
- 6. Nominations may be submitted in writing, by the close of school, two (2) days prior to the election. Written nominations should be submitted only after verifying that the nominee is willing to serve. The Building Representative shall give written verification for any written nominations received.
- 7. Printed ballots shall list all names alphabetically.
- 8. The time and date of the election shall be decided by the School Chapter Advisory Committee, which shall establish procedures so that all members in good standing shall have a reasonable opportunity to vote.
- 9. Use the enclosed nomination and election bulletin to specify the date, time, and place for the nominations meeting and election. The nominations meeting shall be held at least five (5) school days in advance of the election.
- 10. The Building Representative and SCAC must establish a Tally Committee to count the ballots. No person running for office can serve on the Tally Committee. All candidates shall have the right to have observers when the ballots are tallied.
- 11. Results of the elections shall be shared with all teachers on the date of the ballot counting. The Building Representative shall secure and hold all election materials and voting results until **September 1, 2023.**
- 12. Challenges to the elections for all positions shall be submitted in writing to the Executive Board for appropriate action within fifteen (15) days after the election.


