Why a Strike Vote?

A strike vote is our chance to show solidarity and make sure our voices are heard! By voting in favor of a strike, we send a powerful message that we are united and ready to take action if needed to secure a fair and respectful contract.

What Does This Mean?

- It strengthens our bargaining power: A strong strike vote shows management that we are serious about negotiating a fair deal.
- It protects our rights: We're fighting for fair wages, better working conditions, and a better future for all YukonU employees.
- It shows solidarity: This vote isn't just for us but also for the next generation of employees. Standing together now helps ensure the future of workers at YukonU.

How to Vote:
